

STANDARD COLOR TONES for AGLAIA Wood glazes and AGLAIA Natural Resin Lacquers

Glazing or covering surface treatment of wood indoors and outdoors – AGLAIA meets virtually any design requirement. And it does with full-declaration, plant based coatings of a natural esthetic with an absolutely ecological profile being open-pored and free of artificial resins of any kind.



► AGLAIA WEATHER PROTECTION LACQUER

Highly covering, silky oil lacquer for weathered wood outdoors, for wooden windows, framework and sidings. No tendency to flake off even when subject to intensive weathering. Therefore, especially maintenance-friendly. For weather protection lacquers, shorter maintenance intervals will have to be considered when using colors atypical for wood (full color ultrablue).

► AGLAIA INTERIOR LACQUER, glossy or satin-matt

Suitable for coatings indoors, for abrasion-resistant natural resin oil lacquer coatings on doors and furniture. High-quality coatings are obtained when carefully preparing and pretreating the surface with AGLAIA PRECOATER. Steel should be de-rusted and primed with AGLAIA CORROSION PROTECTION PAINT. Application by brush, roller or spraygun in thin layers. Ensure proper ventilation and heat while drying. Like more colors? ► AGLAIA WOOD GLAZE for indoors and outdoors

This classical AGLAIA WOOD GLAZE is available in an „oily“, particularly elastic quality for outdoors, recommended for wooden windows, sidings and framework. The perfectly harmonized combination of plant oils and pure citrus peel oil together with fine-grinded mineral pigments provides glaze coats without tendency to flake off even when subject to severe weathering. Like any purely natural product, AGLAIA WOOD GLAZES are completely free of biocides, fungicides or toxic chemical-synthetical wood preservatives. A major prerequisite for coatings to last without the use of toxic substances is a proper structural wood protection and selection. Outdoors, wood components should be primed and coated two or three times with AGLAIA WOOD GLAZE. The 14 UV-resistant glaze color tones recommended for outdoor use may be mixed with each other as desired. AGLAIA WOOD GLAZE for indoors, satin-matt, is exclusively suitable for applications indoors, e.g. furniture, doors, sidings and wooden toys. Among the main features of this soft glaze are an increased resistance against mechanical stress and a fine satin-matt look. Color tones as for outdoors, plus glaze white (03), gentian (18) and clear (01).

AGLAIA AQUASOL WOOD GLAZE

This innovative, absolutely solvent-free wood glaze is suitable without restriction for both indoors and outdoors. As soon as the water has evaporated, a non-water-swallowable, elastic, highly weather-resistant film is obtained. For a durable coating outdoors, any color tone is appropriate, except clear (01), glaze white (03) and gentian (18).

For any glaze system the slightly shorter maintenance intervals when using color tones atypical for wood (e.g. sky blue) are to be considered.

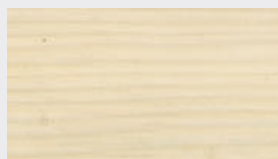

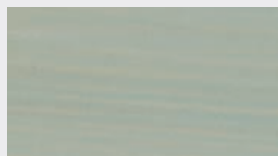

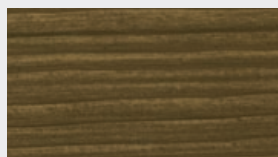
